2. **Review- Math:** Today’s review is count, read, write to 120, and tally marks.

Part 1: Students should be able to count, read, and write to 120. Try to see how far you can go.

Part 2: Students should be able to record tally marks for a given number. Remember to cross the 5th tally mark over the other four tally marks made. Take tally marks.

3. **Daily Quick Write:** What was your favorite part of 1st grade?

*Be sure to write at least 3 sentences and a picture to match! Use capital letters and punctuation!

4. **Practice Writing Your Name:**

Start by writing your first name- be sure the first letter of your name is capitalized.

If you can do that, challenge yourself by writing your first and last name! Be sure the first letter of your first and last name are capitalized.

5. **Field Day!**

Kick off your last week right by having a field day! Get ready to have some fun at home and celebrate all your hard work this year. Everyone can join in. Create an obstacle course using things like cones, tables, chairs, jump ropes, balls, crab walks, beams, etc. Have it inside or outside and have fun completing it. Once you finish your course, try to complete it in reverse (backwards). You can even have a sack race using a pillow case or a trash bag to race in OR you could have a spoon race. Get a spoon and something to put on the spoon like a grape, bead, egg, ball). Race around moving as fast as you can without the object falling off the spoon. Take pictures of your field day and send them to your teacher! Have some Monday fun! :)

Part 2: Students should be able to add and subtract within 20 by using any of the strategies below (It does not matter which one they use!)

Strategies:

- Draw a 10 frame
- Draw a picture (circles are easiest)
- Use some type of counters
- Use a number line
- Counting on/down
- Use your brain

Part 1: Students should be able to add within 100 without regrouping. Remember to add the ones place first and then add the tens place!

Part 2: Students should be able to determine the number of tens and ones within a number and build it using a drawing. Students should also be able to determine if a number is greater than ($>$), less than ($<$), or equal to ($=$) another number.


